

ORDINANCE NO. 09222021-1

**AN ORDINANCE TO REGULATE TRAFFIC ON PORTIONS OF LAKEVILLE ROAD
IN THE TOWN OF WALWORTH**

STATE OF WISCONSIN
Town of Walworth
Walworth County

The Town Board of the Town of Walworth, Walworth County, Wisconsin, has the specific authority under s. 349.11, Wis. stats., to adopt this ordinance.

This ordinance, adopted by a majority of the Town board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, provides for the reduction of the speed limits on certain town highways in the Town as follows:

A. Pursuant to s. 349.11, Wis. stats., effective October 1, 2021, speed limits on certain Town of Walworth town highways are reduced or modified as follows: Lakeville Road from Ridge Road 3600 feet to the East will be reduced from 45 mph to 35 mph and Lakeville Road 3200 feet East of Ridge Road traveling West to Ridge Road intersection will be reduced from 45 mph to 35 mph.

B. Pursuant to s. 349.11 (5), Wis. stats., the town chairperson, or his or her designee, shall place appropriate traffic signs at the above-described locations on or before the effective date of this ordinance.

C. No person may operate any vehicle on the above-noted town highways in violation of the above-noted speed limits. Any violation shall be subject to penalties under s. 346.60, Wis. stats.

This Ordinance shall be effective from and after its passage and posting or publication according to law.

The town clerk shall properly post or publish this ordinance as required under s. 60.80, Wis. stats.
