RESOLUTION OF TOWN ELECTORS TO ADOPT THE TOTAL TOWN TAX LEVY AT SPECIAL TOWN MEETING OF TOWN ELECTORS

Whereas, Wis. Stat. § 60.10(1)(a) authorizes the town electors of a town to adopt the town tax levy at a town meeting of the electors;

The town electors of the <u>Town of Walworth, Walworth County</u>, Wisconsin adopt the total town tax levy for 2022 (to be collected in 2023) in the amount of <u>\$963,105.00</u> [LLW Line 11 – insert the <u>total</u> town tax levy to be collected, <u>including both the approved levy increase and any debt service payments and other adjustments taken on the worksheet].</u>
