

ORDINANCE NO. 1113 2023-1

1. Supervisors.

- a. The Town Board shall have five (5) supervisors. The Chairperson and two supervisors shall be elected at the regular Spring election in odd numbered years to serve a two-year term. So that the terms of the town supervisors are staggered, the other two supervisors shall be elected at the regular Spring election in even numbered years.
- b. The Supervisors shall be numbered 1 through 4. Supervisors No. 2 and No. 4 shall be elected at the regular Spring election in even numbered years. The Chairperson, Supervisor No. 1 and Supervisor No. 3 shall be elected at the regular Spring election in odd numbered years to serve a two-year term. The provision for staggered terms shall take effect as provided in Paragraph c below.
- c. The staggered terms provided in Paragraph b shall be implemented and applied to the regular Spring election of 2024. The two supervisors receiving the highest number of votes in that election year shall serve two-year terms. The Chairperson and the other two supervisors elected in the Spring election of 2025 shall serve two-year terms so that elections occur in both odd numbered and even numbered years.
- d. The seat numbers referenced in above 1b shall only be used in identifying what seats are up for election in that particular election year. The two largest vote getters shall be the two individuals elected to the Town Board.

2. Effective Date.

- a. This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon passage by a two-third (2/3) vote of the Town Board and posting or publication by the town clerk as required by Wis. Stats. ¶ 60.80.
